## PRIVATE FIRE HYDRANT TESTING RELEASE FORM

The above Party or Person, who is the property owner or has been authorized by the property owner to act on its behalf for purpose of this Release, authorizes Western State Fire Protection to conduct hydrant testing and inspection of the private hydrant(s) at the above location. Under no circumstance will Western State Fire Protection flow hydrant(s) when ambient temperatures are below 40 degrees. All stop boxes must be located by authorizing party or person prior to hydrant testing and inspection.

Should authorizing party request Western States Fire Protect to flow hydrant(s) without location of the stop box, customer assumes full liability for any fees or costs assessed by the water authority if the hydrant valve fails to shut off the water flow.

The Authorizing Party or Person above shall continue to be responsible for all maintenance of such hydrant, including, but not limited to, repairing, and maintaining unobstructed visual and physical access to all such hydrants. In addition, the Authorizing Party or Person is, and shall continue to be, responsible for the costs of any and all water used to inspect and/or test such hydrant.

The Authorizing Party or Person hereby releases, and shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Western State Fire Protection and its officers, employees, parent and subsidiary companies, and insurers, from any claim, liability, judgment, damage, loss, and costs of any kind, including, but not limited to property damage, economic loss, personal injury, consequential, indirect or special damages, and reasonable attorney's fees, by anyone arising or allegedly arising from the condition, operation, testing, or inspection of the subject private hydrant and related improvements except those caused by WSFP's negligence or willful misconduct.
